### **Response A**

Section 31(1)(a) of the FOI Act states: 31(1) Information which is not exempt information by virtue of section 30 is exempt information if its disclosure under this Act would, or would be likely to, prejudice (a) the prevention or detection of crime. We believe that if this information were released into the public domain it has a clear likelihood of exposing detail of the Trust's IT infrastructure that could aid cyber criminals to identify weaknesses in the infrastructure and expose it to cyber attack by providing a level of detail we would not publish to the public.

### **Response B**

Section 43(2) of the FOI Act exempts information whose disclosure would, or would be likely to, prejudice the commercial interests of any legal person (an individual, a company, the public authority itself or any other legal entity). To protect the commercial interests of the parties involved this information will not be disclosed.
